

LA GALLO NERO 2025 RULES

La Gallo Nero is a competitive event with timed sections and cycle tourism sections, aimed at promoting the hosting area.

Event rules comply with the Detailed Rules for the National Amateur Sector of the Italian Cycling Federation.

ART. 1 – DAY AND PLACE

The event will take place on Sunday September 28th in Radda in Chianti (SI) - Italy

START AND FINISH: Village Gallo Nero, gardens of Piazza IV Novembre - Radda in Chianti (SI)

TIME:

- Saturday, September 27th 2025 from 2PM to 6PM
- Sunday, September 28th 2025 from 7AM to 3.30PM (finish-line refreshment stand closes)

ROUTES: 133 Km and 60 Km

ART. 2 – ROUTES AND START TIMES

Upon registering, participants may select the route most suitable to them. Must be 18 years or older to register.

START:

- "Cosimo III" = 60 km, start time from 8:30 to 9 AM
- "Gallo Nero" = 133 km, start time from 8 to 8:30 AM with 2 timed sections

Timekeeping will be carried out by STS-EVODATA using "one chip" technology.

The timed sections, which will be closed to traffic for a maximum of 2 hours and will contribute to the final individual women's and men's rankings, will be as follows:

LUIANO HILL CLIMB (appx. 4 Km)

CANAGLIA HILL CLIMB (appx. 3 Km)

Further details to be announced.

ATTENTION:

Each hill climb will have a specific "gate" opening and closing time set by the organizer, which will be communicated to participants.

Once a specific "gate" closing time has passed, timekeeping will no longer be carried out and staff will no longer be present.

To be eligible for prizes, each participant must be timed on all hill climbs included in the chosen route.

To be eligible for prizes, each participant must pass through the designated checkpoints provided by the organizer along the routes.

To be eligible for prizes, each participant must complete the lap within the time limit specified in point 2 of these regulations.

In accordance with UCI and FCI Regulations, paragraphs 1.3.010 and 12.1.013 bis on technological fraud, the race jury, with the technical support of the event Organizer, is authorized to carry out random or systematic checks.

All routes are marked by arrows, but participants must refer to the “Road Book”. Routes and GPS tracks are available for consultation and may be downloaded from the route page found at www.lagallonero.it.

ART. 3 – CHIP RULES

The EVODATA OneChip will be used for this event and must be valid for the year 2025. If your chip is not enabled, you can activate it solely for this event for a fee of €5.00. Participants who do not have their own OneChip can rent one for €5.00, in addition to a refundable deposit of €5.00.

ATTENTION: the use of the chip is mandatory for the “Gallo Nero” route for organizational and safety reasons. Timing is NOT guaranteed for those who do not position the chip correctly.

ART. 4 - CYCLING MEMBERSHIP CARD

In order to comply with Italian regulations, at the time of registration all athletes must be members of the Italian Cycling Federation, or organizations affiliated with said Federation.

There are two registration categories:

- Amateur cyclist (competitive level) - “Gallo Nero” route
- Bicycle tourist (NON-competitive level) - “Cosimo III” route

However, cyclists not belonging to any cycling club may sign up for the ‘La Gallo Nero’ event by signing up for the daily insurance as specified below:

- Amateur cyclist - “Gallo Nero” route –FCI daily membership card for € 15,00
- Bicycle tourist - “Cosimo III” route – FCI daily membership card for € 15,00

The event Organizer may, at any time and at its sole discretion, decide whether to accept or refuse registration to the event, or whether to exclude enrolled participants should they in any way damage the image of the event.

ART. 5 - CERTIFICATE OF FITNESS FOR SPORTS PRACTICE

All participants must possess a valid certificate of fitness for sports practice (for cycling).

The type of certificate of fitness for sports practice necessary shall depend on the type of route chosen and on the type of club membership, as governed by the implementing rules of the Italian Cycling Federation.

Participation in the 133 km cycling event is subject to the valid possession of one of the following requirements.

- For athletes registered as members of the Italian Cycling Federation or other Sports Promotion Authority: certificate of fitness for competitive cycling pursuant to Ministerial Decree 18/02/82 (certificates of fitness for different sports, such as triathlon, duathlon, track, etc., shall not be deemed valid).
- For athletes resident in Italy, but not registered as members of the Italian Cycling Federation or other Sports Promotion Authority: certificate of fitness for competitive cycling pursuant to Ministerial Decree 18/02/82.
- For athletes residing in a foreign country: certificate of fitness for participation in competitive cycling events issued by a doctor of their country of residence ([LINK](#)).

Participation in the 60 km (non-competitive) cycling event is subject to the valid possession of one of the following requirements.

- For Italian athletes registered as members of the Italian Cycling Federation or other Sports Promotion Authority: certificate of fitness for non-competitive cycling or certificate of fitness for high-intensity cardio sports practice pursuant to Ministerial Decree dated 24/04/13 ([LINK](#)). For Italian athletes aged 70 or more (solar age), a certificate of fitness for competitive cycling pursuant to Ministerial Decree DM 18/02/82 is required.
- For athletes resident in Italy, but not registered as members of the Italian Cycling Federation or other Sports Promotion Authority: certificate of fitness for non-competitive cycling or certificate of fitness for high-intensity cardio sports practice pursuant to Ministerial Decree dated 24/04/13 ([LINK](#)). For Italian athletes aged 70 or more (solar age), a certificate of fitness for competitive cycling pursuant to Ministerial Decree DM 18/02/82 is required.
- For athletes residing in a foreign country: certificate of fitness for participation in non-competitive cycling events or certificate of fitness for high-intensity cardio sports practice, or an equivalent certificate, issued also by a doctor of their country of residence ([LINK](#)). For foreign athletes aged 70 or more (solar age), a certificate of fitness for competitive cycling pursuant to Ministerial Decree DM 18/02/82 is required.

Pursuant to Presidential Decree No.445 of December 28th 2000, participants must declare that all documents uploaded on the ENDU system are accurate and correspond to the original documents in their possession.

ART. 6 - TERMS AND REGISTRATION FEES

All registrations must be made through Endu.net.

- **From Opening of online registrations to May 20th 2025** PROMOTIONAL RATE €35,00 with t-shirt (and race pack)
- **From May 21th to June 30th 2025** €45,00 with commemorative t-shirt (and race pack) or €35,00 without commemorative t-shirt (with race pack)
- **From July 1st to August 25th 2025** €50,00 with commemorative t-shirt (and race pack) or €35,00 without commemorative t-shirt (with race pack)
- **From August 26th to September 25th 2025** €40,00 without commemorative t-shirt (with race pack)
- **On September 27th and 28th** €45,00 without commemorative t-shirt (with race pack)

The registration fee includes: race pack, refreshments along the route, medical assistance during the event, water at the finish line, end-of-event refreshments, changing rooms and showers, attended bicycle parking at the Village.

ART. 7 - REPLACEMENT OR WITHDRAWAL

Should a registered participant not be able to attend the 2025 La Gallo Nero event, his/her registration fee cannot be reimbursed and the race pack cannot be delivered.

Decision to withdraw from the event must be communicated by and no later than midnight of August 31st 2025 via e-mail sent to pedale39@gmail.com. Within said deadline, your paid registration fee will not be reimbursed, but will be held for the 2026 La Gallo Nero edition. In this case, registration is strictly personal, non-transferable and valid only for the year following cancellation.

From September 1st 2025, your paid registration fee will not be reimbursed, nor held for the following edition.

If the registration fee has been held for the following edition, it must be reactivated by the same athlete before and no later than June 30th 2026 by written request emailed to pedale39@gmail.com. After said date, your registration can no longer be reactivated. There is a € 5 administration fee for reactivation.

ART. 8 - ROAD SAFETY RULES

All participants are obliged, under their own responsibility, to strictly observe the highway code. The organization declines any responsibility for any accidents that may occur before, during, and after the event.

ART. 9 - TECHNICAL INFORMATION PACKAGE AND RACE PACK PICK UP

Your race number and race pack can be picked up at the Village Gallo Nero in Radda in Chianti as follows:

- Saturday, September 27th 2025 from 2PM to 6PM
- Sunday, September 28th 2025 from 7AM to 8.30AM

Unclaimed race packs by the start time of the race will not be delivered nor sent.

ART. 10 - MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

A coordinated Emergency First Aid Rescue Plan approved by the Italian Emergency Operational Center is in place, as required by the Italian Cycling Federation rules. Ambulances and qualified medical staff for emergency first aid and rescue will be in attendance.

We strongly suggest to carry a bike puncture and repair kit throughout the event.

ART. 11 - REFRESHMENT STANDS

There are 4 refreshment stands along the longer route, and 1 refreshment stand for the short route:

- . San Casciano in Val di Pesa
- . San Donato in Poggio
- . Castagnoli (Gaiole)
- . Ponte alle Granchiaie (Gaiole)
- . water at the finish line
- . end-of-event refreshments – at the Gallo Nero Village

All refreshments stands are specially marked a few meters ahead.

ART. 12 - AWARD CEREMONIES

Starting at 1.30PM prizes will be given for the following categories:

- . largest group

Award ceremony for the top 3 men and top 3 women based on the sum of the timed sections, and award ceremony for the overall winners based on the sum of the timed sections of the 12 FCI-recognized categories.

Unclaimed awards will not be sent.

ART. 13 – GENERAL INFORMATION

The event is organized by the Società Sport Angels a.s.d.

ART. 14 – EVENT CANCELLATION

Should the event not take place due to force majeure or to other circumstances beyond the Organizer's control, the registration fee will not be reimbursed nor held valid for next year's edition.

In particular, Tuscany Regional authorities issue weather forecasts using a color system that marks the increasing seriousness of an alert; starting from green (no forecast of intense or dangerous weather events), to yellow and orange, up to red (forecast of extreme weather events that are very dangerous to public health and safety). Taken note of the weather warning, local authorities will have the final word on whether the event will or will not take place.

Should authorities issue an orange or red color weather alert for the day of the race, the event may be modified (by eliminating part of the route), or cancelled entirely. In this case, as it is beyond the Organizer's control, the registration fee will not be reimbursed nor held valid for next year's edition.

ART. 15 - AMENDMENTS

The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the rules at any time. The website www.lagallonero.it is the only official information channel for the event. Therefore, all official communication will be made available on said website.

ART. 16 – RULES OF CONDUCT

Anyone:

- Who should behave in an abusive or insulting manner towards event organizers and staff;
- Who should engage in environmentally unfriendly behaviour, such as discarding trash outside of the bins placed at the refreshments stands and at checkpoints

will not be allowed to participate in next year's event.

We appeal to the civic sense of all participants to keep the areas along the route clean.

ART. 17 – APPROVAL, CONSENT, AUTHORIZATION, ETC.

By requesting to participate in the La Gallo Nero in any of the ways described by the Rules herein, from the time of registration the applicant:

- Declares to have read and approved these Rules and to accept them in their entirety;
- Personally guarantees for his/her behaviour during and after the event;
- Declares to be in good physical condition and to have supplied the organization with a valid health certificate issued upon successful completion of a physical examination specifically assessing fitness for competitive or non-competitive cycling, thus fully releasing the Organization from any responsibility for damage or injury resulting from his/her participation in the event;
- Agrees to the use of his/her personal data, also for commercial use, in accordance with the provisions of the Italian Privacy Code No. 196 of 30/06/2003 and with the European Union Regulation on privacy 2017/679 (GDPR/18);
- Grants the event organizers - to the fullest extent possible not inconsistent with law - the right to use, also for profit, any photo or video image taken during the days of the event, thus offering the event organizers the right to transfer said rights to images to third parties.

Said authorization to the use of their personal image is to be considered as granted for an indefinite period and with no territorial limits worldwide, for use in any publication and footage, thus including but not limited to, promotional and/or advertising material on any media. The event Organizer may also transfer the above mentioned rights of use to third parties and to its institutional and commercial partners.

Neither the event Organizer, nor any of its collaborators, shall be liable for any accident or damage to things and people that might occur before, during and after the event, or as a consequence thereof.

ART. 18 – E-BIKES

E-bikes will not be equipped with a Chip, therefore they will not be ranked and will not be awarded prizes. Anyone who wants to use this type of bicycle will have to proceed in cycle tourism mode.
